- 1 One copy of your TOEFL score is required. You do not have to submit the original official score report. Please do not send it directly from ETS Center to the University of Tokyo. Please make sure to upload the documents before the online application deadline.
- 2 Only TOEFL scores are accepted (IELTS, TOEIC or other scores are not accepted).
- 3 You can submit the certificate of English as the medium of instruction from your university instead of the TOEFL score. One original document needs to be submitted. If the original document is not available, the School of Engineering accepts copies only when they are attested to be accurate facsimiles of the original with original stamps of attestation from a suitable legal entity. Attestations can be provided by the academic institute where the documents were issued, a local notary, embassy, or public authority responsible for educational administration. If the language of instruction is stated in your transcript, you do not have to submit the certificate of English as medium of instruction. In that case, please highlight the part which states it in your transcript.
